CUAHSI Science Plan Released

CUAHSI is pleased to announce the release of the CUAHSI Science Plan, entitled *Hydrology of a Dynamic Earth: A Decadal Research Plan for Hydrologic Science* for your review and comment. This report is the culmination of many months of effort by the Science Advisory Team, led by John Wilson and assisted by Kevin Dressler.

Comments are due by May 15 if we are to consider them in the final version of the science plan. Although we welcome your comments on any aspect of the plan, we ask you to focus on Section 3, the implementation plan. Are these the activities of highest priority for our community during the coming decade? What else should be added? What is your opinion of the proposed phases and staging of these efforts?
